ORDER

Upon consideration of the petition for a writ of certiorari to the Appellate Court of Maryland filed by Adnan Syed, the cross-petition filed by Young Lee, as Victim's Representative, the answer to the petition and cross-petition filed by the State of Maryland, in which it agrees that both the petition and cross-petition should be granted, and the answer to the cross-petition filed by Adnan Syed opposing the granting of the cross-petition, and upon noting that Young Lee did not file an answer to the petition for a writ of certiorari, it is this 28th day of June, 2023, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,

ORDERED, that the petition and the cross-petition are both GRANTED, and a writ of certiorari shall issue to the Appellate Court of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED, that this case is transferred to the regular docket as No. 7, September Term, 2023 (SCM-REG-0007-2023); and it is further

ORDERED, that the petitioner's brief and record extract shall be filed on or before August 2, 2023. The respondent's brief and respondent/cross-petitioner's brief shall be filed

on or before August 28, 2023. The cross-respondent's brief shall be filed on or before September 22, 2023. The respondent's reply brief and respondent/cross-petitioner's reply brief, if any, shall be filed on or before September 29, 2023. The parties' briefs and the record extract shall be filed through the MDEC system in accordance with Maryland Rules 8-501, 8-502, 20-403, 20-404, and 20-406¹; and it is further

ORDERED, that this case shall be set for argument during the October 2023 session of the Court, with argument scheduled on October 5, 2023.
