| POAC (Professional Outplacement Assistance Center) | Provides assistance to individuals who are in the professional, executive, technical, managerial, and scientific occupations. Offers state of the art computer lab, individualized career guidance, and audio-visual library |
| Power52  | Provides employment training for at-risk adults, returning citizens, and underserved individuals living in Baltimore City and surrounding counties that prepares participants for careers in the solar industry.             |
| Pro Bono Counseling Project                        | Provides access to free mental health care to individuals, families and couples who cannot receive care from any other source.   |
