1. Modify Section 2- Statement of Work

2.1 Purpose & Summary

Judicial Information Systems (JIS) is the division of the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) charged with providing Information Technology (IT) services to the Maryland Judiciary.

The AOC is seeking proposals from prospective Offerors to award a Field Network Technicians. This solicitation will may result in multiple awards. A total of three resources are required. Located in Annapolis, Maryland, Judicial Information Systems (JIS) is comprised of six units including application development and support, hardware installation and maintenance, operation of the Data Center computer systems, and support of online case management and business applications at the District and Circuit Courts across the state.

Offerors may propose up to ~~three (3)~~ five (5) candidates.

The AOC reserves the right to disqualify any candidate proposed by multiple Offerors. Affected Offerors will be given three business days to submit a substitute.

The AOC reserves the right to make additional awards of like staff as awarded within the Contractor pool during the life of the contract at the proposed labor rates. The AOC reserves the right to roll off support staff with 30-day notice, if assignments are completed prior to contract expiration.
