HIRING INFORMATION FOR JUSTICE ANGELA M. EAVES

Clerkships:

Justice Eaves employs two Law Clerks, who serve a one-year term typically beginning in mid-August. Justice Eaves has completed hiring for the 2025–2026 term and currently is accepting applications for the 2026–2027 term. Current law students must have at least three semesters' worth of grades. While the application review process begins on a rolling basis in January of each year, offers to interview typically are sent in early February.

Applicants should submit a cover letter, resume, official law school transcript, two writing samples (no more than fifteen pages each), and either a list of references, letters of recommendation, or a combination of the two (no more than three collectively). These materials should be sent electronically—as a single PDF file—to Justice Eaves' Senior Law Clerk, Trevor Bernard, at Trevor.Bernard@mdcourts.gov. If your letters of recommendation will be sent separately, please indicate in your email the recommender(s) whose letter(s) will be forthcoming.

Internships:

Justice Eaves accepts applications from law students and recent law graduates for unpaid judicial internships for the fall, spring, and summer semesters. Applications must be received by the following dates to be considered for that respective semester:

Summer internship: Application due by February 15th
Fall internship: Application due by June 15th

• Spring internship: Application due by November 15th

Applicants should submit a cover letter, resume, unofficial or official law school transcript, a list of references (optional), and one writing sample (no more than ten pages). Please note in the cover letter the semester for which you are applying and whether you are pursuing the internship for academic credit and any requirements for you to receive credit. These materials should be sent electronically—as a single PDF file—to Justice Eaves' Senior Law Clerk, Trevor Bernard, at Trevor.Bernard@mdcourts.gov. Please note, Justice Eaves does not hire interns (past or current) for future clerkship openings. If you think you may be interested in working for Justice Eaves as a Law Clerk after graduation, then Justice Eaves strongly recommends that you seek internship opportunities with other judges/justices.
