

The Out-of-State Attorneys' Bar Examination is for any applicant who has been admitted to the Bar of another state in the United States by written examination and who possesses a minimum aggregate total of five years of qualifying professional experience out of the ten most recent years preceding the date the application is filed or who possesses an aggregate total of ten years or more of qualifying experience regardless of recency.

Qualifying professional experience must have been full time and must have been the principal means of earning your livelihood. Your experience must have been as a practitioner of law, or as a teacher at an American Bar Association approved law school, or as a judge of a court of record, or any combination of these three.
