Alan M. Wilner is retired from serving over thirty years on the Bench as both a Court of Appeals and Court of Special Appeals Judge. He currently serves as Chair of the Court of Appeals Standing Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure, which is in the process of rewriting the Rules on court-annexed ADR. Prior to being appointed to the Bench, he was an Assistant Attorney General of Maryland, Chief Legislative Officer in the Office of the Governor, as well as an Associate at Sherbow, Shea & Doyle and Venable, Baetjer & Howard. Judge Wilner has taught Alternative Dispute Resolution at the University of Maryland and University of Baltimore Law Schools. His honors include the Professional Legal Excellence Award for Advancement of Professional Competence by the Maryland Bar Foundation, one of the Daily Record's named Influential Marylanders, as well as an Honorary Membership in the Order of the Coif. Judge Wilner attended Baltimore City College, The Johns Hopkins University, and the University of Maryland School of Law.
