



People Needing Assistance Area of **R**escue **A**ssistance

PLAN

Emergency evacuation plans should provide for prompt and effective assistance to individuals whose medical conditions require assistance. Building/floor coordinators* may ask all employees to voluntarily self-identify if they will need assistance in the event of an evacuation. Some conditions may be obvious, but not need assistance; others will not be visibly apparent. People with disabilities are generally in the best position to assess their particular needs.

PROCEDURE

In the event of an emergency, evacuations of buildings may be necessary. It is important for the Building and Floor Coordinators to know of any individuals within their area that may need attention during evacuation. During an emergency, the building/floor coordinator should assist/escort an individual needing assistance to the Area of **R**escue **A**ssistance. The building/floor coordinator will notify emergency personnel of the location of the person(s) in need of assistance.

SELF-IDENTIFICATION – CONFIDENTIAL INFORMATION

Persons in need of assistance must decide for themselves whether they initially choose to self-identify and request assistance during an emergency situation.
