**PEER RECOVERY ADVOCATE**

Cecil County Circuit Court is seeking a **Peer Recovery Advocate**, FT with a starting hourly rate of \$14.00. This position is responsible for providing peer-to-peer support for Drug Court participants and works 40 hours per week. ***This position is contractual and is contingent upon grant funding approval on an annual basis.***

**Position requirements:** High School Diploma; previous peer advocacy training and/or experience; minimum of (2) two years of recovery from substance abuse addiction, (5) five years preferred; must have a valid Driver's License. This position will not act in a clinical capacity other than through the use of assessment tools which will be reviewed with supervisor.

**Duties:** Include, but not limited to, assisting participants in identifying and connecting with appropriate recovery supports, developing motivation for recovery, and establishing/ maintaining recovering lifestyles. The advocate will work with participants in various substance abuse treatment settings to access services determined by assessment, problem identification, and individualized treatment planning to be of value to the participant. Must have familiarity with treatment and community resources that support recovery from addictive disease and co-occurring behavioral health disorders. Must have the ability to maintain effective peer recovery relationships with participants and other members of the Drug Court team; perform all other duties as assigned.
