We provide free limited legal services for people who are unrepresented.

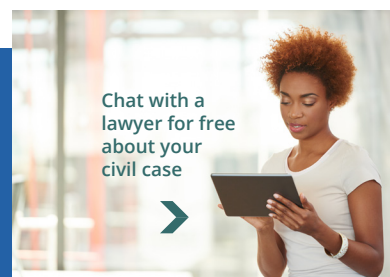
- **The person with the legal problem.** We cannot help relatives or agents of the person with the legal problem or other third parties.
