The Maryland Mediation and Conflict Resolution Office (MACRO) is a 40-member multi-disciplinary group created and chaired by the Honorable Robert M. Bell, Chief Judge of Maryland's highest court. MACRO is working to advance the appropriate use of mediation, arbitration and other dispute resolution processes in every sector of society, including the business sector. As part of this effort, MACRO has formed a Business Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) Initiative to promote ADR throughout Maryland's business community.

The Maryland Business ADR Initiative urges Maryland law firms to have lawyers in their firms be knowledgeable about ADR and to discuss ADR with clients in all appropriate cases. This Pledge obliges subscribing law firms to seriously explore negotiation, mediation, arbitration or other ADR processes in conflicts arising with other Pledge signatories before pursuing full-scale litigation.
