ORDER

This matter came before the Court on the Joint Petition for Disbarment by Consent filed by the Attorney Grievance Commission of Maryland and the Respondent, Brandon D. ORDERED, that Respondent, Brandon D. Ross, be and he is hereby disbarred from the practice of law in the State of Maryland, effective immediately; and it is further

ORDERED, that, the Clerk of the Court shall remove the name Brandon D. Ross from the register of attorneys in the Court and certify that fact to the Client Protection Fund of the Bar of Maryland and all Clerks of all judicial tribunals in this State in accordance with Maryland Rule 19-736(d).
