Questions/Responses No. 3 to the Request for Proposals (RFP) K16-0013-29

Oracle Business Intelligence Application Development Services Resources

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The following questions for the above referenced RFP were received by e-mail and are answered and posted for all prospective Offerors. The statements and interpretations contained in the following responses to questions are not binding on the Maryland Judiciary unless the RFP is expressly amended. Nothing in the Maryland Judiciary's response to these questions is to be construed as agreement to or acceptance by the Maryland Judiciary of any statement or interpretation on the part of the Offeror asking the question.

75. Question: What are the systems managed for the MD Courts? Is there a Data Center where privileged access needs to be requested?

Response: The Data Center is located at 2661 Riva Road, Annapolis MD 21401.

Yes –privileged access will need to be given.

76. Question: When establishing initial and incremental load plans, will we source the Production PeopleSoft environment or will MD Courts manage a clone to production data?

Response: AOC/JIS can provide a copy of the database.

77. Question: How many reports on a dashboard?

Response: To be determined in Phase I.

78. Question: Are report requirements known? Will they be based of OLTP Standard report designs, or will they require any data transformation, etc.?

Response: It is expected that there will be a mapping from the production database to the data warehouse.

79. Question: What is the size/volume of the PeopleSoft data source?

Response: Current production database for finance is about 260GB.

80. Question: What is the anticipated incremental frequency of data updates (daily, weekly)?

Response: Daily.

81. Question: Does MD Courts have a system development lifecycle (SDLC that we will have to conform to?

Response: SDLC on the Maryland DOIT site.

82. Question: If a company is registered to do business in Maryland, will a SBA minority owned small business certification be equal to a MBE certification?

Response: No.

83. Question: Does lack of MBE certification disqualify you from bidding?

Response: No. A prime that is not a MBE, must subcontract in accordance with RFP section 1.23 or submit a waiver. Failure to do either one will result in a disqualification.

84. Question: Are attachments A, E, G, H, I and K to be submitted with the proposal? If so, where?

Response: See RFP section 3.4.5.6 for a list of the required attachments. Required attachments must be placed at the end of the Technical Proposal.

85. Question: How many analytics do you want to implement?

Response: To be determine in Phase I.

86. Question: What are the analytics you purchased and want to implement?

Response: Oracle Financial Analytics Fusion Edition & Oracle Procurement and Spend Analytics Fusion Edition

87. Question: What PeopleSoft modules do you want to configure with the analytics?

Response: Order-to-Cash, GL, AR, Purchasing, e-procurement, Grants.

88. Question: What are the exact number of data sources for the OBIE reports/dashboards?

Response: To be determined during phase I.

89. Question: Please explain if AOC wants to integrate any data stored in custom tables.

Response: Yes. Data from custom tables could be used to populate the Dashboards.

90. Question: Please explain the level of customization in their PeopleSoft application – simple, medium or complex.

Response: The level of customization could be classified as medium. No core tables or processes have been customized.

91. Question: Can we assume a portion of the 10 custom reports are part of each of these dashboards?

Response: Yes.
