Installation of Cell Phone Signal Boosters for Maryland Judiciary's Annapolis Complex

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The following questions for the above referenced RFP were received by e-mail and are answered and posted for all prospective Offerors who received the RFP. The statements and interpretations contained in the following responses to questions are not binding to the Maryland Judiciary unless the RFP is expressly amended. Nothing in the Maryland Judiciary's response to these questions is to be construed as agreement to or acceptance by the Maryland Judiciary of any statement or interpretation on the part of the Offeror asking the question.

- 1. Question: Will attendees be allowed to photograph the sites in order to develop the response to the RFP? **Response: Yes.**
- 2. Question: What is the estimated/planned duration of the entire conference, including the site visit?

Response: Approximately 3-4 hours.

3. Question: In reference to the requirement that the "solution must not interfere with other frequencies", are there any interfering frequencies and sources currently known, or will Offerors be required to investigate, find and locate sources of interference?

Response: Vendors must evaluate if any potential interference is possible based on existing equipment in the buildings. If no other systems are operating on the same frequencies as the cell systems, there should be no interference.

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4. Question: In reference to the requirement that the "solution must be relocatable and reusable", please elaborate on the meaning of "re-locatable and reusable. If the proposed solution has some permanently anchored components, and other components that are located between the walls, that can be relocated and reused with additional engineering work, is this considered re-locatable and reusable?

Response: It is understood that antennas will be affixed to the building and wiring run within walls and chases. The antennas must be able to be removed by unbolting from its mount, interior repeaters should be able to be relocated to other facilities with appropriate engineering and rewiring.
