

**Grant Name:** OVW Fiscal Year 2016 Grants to Enhance Culturally Specific Services for Victims

**Purpose:** To create “an opportunity for culturally specific community-based organizations to address the critical needs of sexual assault, domestic violence, dating violence, and stalking victims in a manner that affirms a victim’s culture and effectively addresses language and communication barriers.”

**Amount of Funds Available:** Awards under this program will be made for up to \$300,000. Awards typically range from \$250,000 to \$300,000. It is estimated that up to 20 awards will be made for an estimated total of \$6,000,000.

**Eligible Applicants:** Applicants are limited to private nonprofit organizations for which the primary purpose of the organization as a whole is to provide culturally specific services to American Indians, Asian Americans, Native Hawaiians and other Pacific Islanders, Blacks, or Hispanics.
