Purpose: This program has two goals:(1) Establish and strengthen collaboration among communities, public and private non-profit agencies; as well as federal, state, local, and tribal governments to support the efforts of community coalitions working to prevent and reduce substance use among youth and (2) Reduce substance use among youth and, over time, reduce substance abuse among adults by addressing the factors in a community that increase the risk of substance abuse and promoting the factors that minimize the risk of substance abuse”

Amount of Funds Available: Estimated \$8,750,000 total with \$125,000 award ceiling

Eligible Applicants: Eligible applicants are community-based coalitions addressing youth substance use that have never received a Drug-Free Communities Support Program grant; or have previously received a Drug-Free Communities Support Program grant, but experienced a lapse in funding; or have concluded the first five-year funding cycle and are applying for a second five-year funding cycle. Applicants must meet all Statutory Eligibility Requirements.
