

Joint Adult Drug Court Solicitation to Enhance Services, Coordination, and Treatment FY 2016 Competitive Grant Announcement

The Bureau of Justice Assistance (BJA) and the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) are now accepting applications for fiscal year 2016 for grants to enhance court services, coordination, and evidence-based substance abuse treatment and recovery support services of adult drug courts.

Deadline: May 31, 2016

Eligible applicants are limited to states or state courts applying on behalf of a single jurisdiction; local courts; counties; other units of local government; or federally recognized Indian tribal governments. Eligible jurisdictions must have a fully operational (at least 1 year as of September 30, 2016) adult drug court.

Applicants can apply for a one-time award from BJA of up to \$400,000 and up to \$325,000 per year for three years from SAMHSA.
