Answer: Please see Appendix 2: Bid/Proposal Affidavit, clause K: Certification of Corporate Registration and Tax Payment. If you meet the qualifications of clause K, then you are qualified to do business in the State of Maryland.

These are the only changes contemplated by Amendment No. 2. All other terms and conditions are in full force and effect.
