The following questions for the above referenced RFP were received by e-mail and are answered and posted for all prospective Offerors who received the RFP. The statements and interpretations contained in the following responses to questions are not binding on the Judiciary unless the RFP is expressly amended. Nothing in the Judiciary's response to these questions is to be construed as agreement to or acceptance by the Judiciary of any statement or interpretation on the part of the Offeror asking the question.

Question 1. I noticed the Judiciary's notes from the pre-proposal conference, page 1, last paragraph, requests "1 (one) original bound proposal ...." However, RFP Section 3.2.2 requests one "unbound" original. Which is preferred for the original, bound or unbound?

## Response: Unbound original.

Question 2. RFP Section 1.28 says other non-State agencies may use the contract to purchase services "at the same prices chargeable to the Maryland Judiciary." Because of the Judiciary's large size and other factors, we would extend a larger discount to the Judiciary than to smaller non-State agencies. For each Functional Area, would the AOC consider separate pricing for the Judiciary and for the other agencies? This would provide the best overall value for the Judiciary. Our pricing for other agencies would be tiered, or varied depending on the number of users per agency.
