

## INFORMATION ON VICTIM(S) AND FAMILY MEMBER(S)

## To the State's Attorney's Office/Victim Witness Coordinator:

- If the respondent files a petition for juvenile record expungement in this case, the court is required to notify victim(s) and certain family members of victim(s).
- A "victim" is a person against whom a delinquent act has been committed or attempted.

A "family member" is an individual who: (1) is a family member of a victim, and (2) attended the adjudication. See Maryland Code, Courts and Judicial Proceedings Article, § 3-8A-27.1(a)(4), (b)(2)(ii).

- Please complete the following information and return it to the clerk's office within 30 days of the adjudication or, if there is no adjudication, the entry of a nolle prosequi or dismissal of the juvenile petition.
