25. Question: In the original RFP it stated that "three years of successfully progressive experience in a service desk technician role can substitute for any or all education requirement" but the most recent QA states candidates must have a bachelor's degree. Can you clarify?

Response: The Judiciary is permitting work experience to substitute education. To clarify the previous QA, we are not removing the option for a bachelor's degree.
