### Questions/Responses No. 1 to the Request for Proposals (RFP) K20-0046-29 JIS Networking Cabling Technician

Ladies and Gentlemen:

The following questions for the above referenced RFP were received by e-mail and are answered and posted for all prospective Offerors. The statements and interpretations contained in the following responses to questions are not binding on the Maryland Judiciary unless the RFP is expressly amended. Nothing in the Maryland Judiciary's response to these questions is to be construed as agreement to or acceptance by the Maryland Judiciary of any statement or interpretation on the part of the Offeror asking the question.

1. Question: Should Security+ be added to this list as well. As the Security + Certification supersede the Network+ certification?

**Response: If a vendor has it, it will be considered in their qualifications.**

2. Question: The Project Manager stated that the technician will have to perform network device configuration - which falls under cybersecurity?

**Response: Basic switch configurations are not considered "cybersecurity", and will bring an over-qualified candidate. The configurations that we may require are in the purview of a "Network Cabling Technician's" skillset.**
