

April 4 MDEC Gets a Facelift

Starting April 4, registered attorneys using the Maryland Electronic Courts (MDEC) e-filing feature will see an entirely new look for the software interface.

The facelift allows MDEC to transition to an upgraded Odyssey File and Serve feature known as the H5.

H5 works seamlessly on all mobile devices (Android or Apple) and supports all browsers — Internet Explorer 10 and 11, Firefox, Chrome and Safari.

Online training videos are available now and beginning on March 22, webinar sessions on the new H5 e-filing interface will be available at <https://maryland.tylerhost.net/OfsWeb>.

Users will have a four-week grace period to transition to H5. During this period, registered users should electronically file using H5. The transition period will end on May 2.

Please note: If you are currently registered, you will not be required to register again.
