O R D E R

ORDERED, by the Court of Appeals of Maryland, that the petition be, and it is hereby, GRANTED, and the petitioner J. Christopher Llinas, upon taking in open court and subscribing to the oath of attorneys required by MD Code (2004), Business Occupations and Professions Article Sec 10-212 is reinstated as a member of the Bar of Maryland to the practice of law in this State, and it is further

ORDERED that Clerk of the Court shall replace the name of J. Christopher Llinas upon the register of attorneys entitled to practice in this Court and certify that fact to the Trustees of the Client Protection Fund and the Clerks of all judicial tribunals in this State, and it is further
