O R D E R

Upon consideration of the Joint Petition of the Attorney Grievance Commission of Maryland and the Respondent, Jewel M. Harmon, to suspend the Respondent from the practice of law in Maryland for 60 days, stayed in favor of one year of probation with terms, it is this 22nd day of July, 2022

ORDERED, that, the suspension be, and hereby is, **STAYED** in favor of one year of probation with the terms contained in the Probation Agreement.
