COVID-19 Revised Protocol Effective June 1, 2021

In accordance with the <u>Second Amended Administrative Order Expanding Statewide</u> <u>Judiciary Operations In Light of the COVID-19 Emergency</u>, effective Tuesday, June 1, 2021, the following COVID-19 protocols are in effect:

- 1. Any employee who is fully vaccinated is not required to wear a mask inside the Courthouse or other offsite Court office buildings. This applies to other Courthouse occupants, justice partners, attorneys, litigants (including prisoners), and members of the public entering the Courthouse.
- 2. Any employee or other person over the age of 2 who is <u>not</u> fully vaccinated is required to wear a mask in the Courthouse and other offsite Court office buildings and <u>must</u> maintain social distancing protocols.
- 3. Due to the number of people required for jury selection, masks and social distancing will be required in the Jury Assembly Room and at the remote jury selection site regardless of vaccine status.
- 4. All persons entering the Courthouse, including employees, <u>must</u> complete the screening questionnaire, submit to a non-contact temperature check, pass through the security scanner, and otherwise follow the directives of Court Security personnel.
- 5. We will not be asking for proof of vaccination from the public or other justice partners.
- 6. Anyone who wishes to wear a mask may continue to do so even if fully vaccinated.
- 7. Social distancing directives as well as plexiglass barriers will continue to be maintained.
