ORDER

By the Court's March 23, 2023, Order, attorney Sherwin M. Shafie (AIS No.0512150177) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409(c), 19-503(c), and 19-605. Attorney Shafie has now requested reinstatement pursuant to those Rules and the Administrative Office of the Courts has confirmed attorney Shafie's compliance with Rules 19-409(c) and 19-503(c). According to the Client Protection Fund, attorney Shafie has not complied with the obligations imposed by Rule 19-605.

Also by the Court's March 23, 2023, Order, attorney Prince Williams (AIS No. 1212130293) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-503 and 19-605. Attorney Williams has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rule 19-503(c) and 19-606(c), and the Administrative Office of the Courts and Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Williams' compliance with Rule 19-503 and 19-605.

Accordingly, it is this 10th day of April 2023, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,

ORDERED that attorney Sherwin M. Shafie (AIS No. 051250177) is recertified pursuant to Rules 19-409(c)(5)(F) and 19-503(c)(6)(A), but remains temporarily suspended pursuant to Rule 19-606(b); and it is further

ORDERED that attorney Prince Williams (AIS No.1212130293) is restored to good standing by the Court and is again permitted to practice law in the State of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Clerk of the Appellate Court of Maryland, the clerks of the circuit courts for the counties and Baltimore City, the Chief Clerk of District Court of Maryland, the Clerk of the Supreme Court of the United States, the Clerk of the United States Court of Appeals for the Fourth Circuit, and the Clerk of the United States District Court for the District of Maryland.
