ORDER

By the Court's April 6, 2009 Order, attorney Carol A. Barron (AIS No. 9006280012) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rule 19-605. Attorney Barron has now requested reinstatement pursuant to Rule 19-606(c), and the Trustees of the Client Protection Fund have confirmed attorney Barron's compliance with Rule 19-605.

Accordingly, it is this 18th day of March 2024, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,
ORDERED that attorney Carol A. Barron (AIS No.9006280012) is restored to good standing by the Court and is again permitted to practice law in the State of Maryland; and it is further
