ORDER

By the Court's October 3, 2018 Order, attorney Eric J. Hougen (AIS No. 9812160034) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409(c) and 19-503(c). Attorney Hougen has now requested reinstatement pursuant to those Rules, and the Administrative Office of the Courts has confirmed attorney Hougen's compliance with Rules 19-409(c) and 19-503(c).

By the Court's March 21, 2024 Order, attorney Julian M. Davis (AIS No. 0112110170) was prohibited from the further practice of law in the State of Maryland for failure to comply with the obligations imposed by Rules 19-409(c) and 19-503(c). Attorney Davis has now requested reinstatement pursuant to those Rules, and the Administrative Office of the Courts has confirmed attorney Davis's compliance with Rules 19-409(c) and 19-503(c).

Accordingly, it is this 19th day of August 2024, by the Supreme Court of Maryland,
ORDERED that attorneys

Eric J. Hougen (AIS No. 9812160034), and

Julian M. Davis (AIS No. 9812160034),

are restored to good standing by the Court and are again permitted to practice law in the State of Maryland; and it is further

ORDERED that the Clerk of this Court shall forward a copy of this Order to the Clerk of the Appellate Court of Maryland, the clerks of the circuit courts for the counties and Baltimore City, the Chief Clerk of District Court of Maryland, the Clerk of the Supreme Court of the United States, the Clerk of the United States Court of Appeals for

the Fourth Circuit, and the Clerk of the United States District Court for the District of Maryland.
