- DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROTECTIVE ORDERS
- CRIMINAL COMPETENCY MATTERS
- CONTEMPT HEARINGS RELATED TO PEACE OR PROTECTIVE ORDERS
- MATTERS INVOLVING LOCALLY INCARCERATED DEFENDANTS
- MOTIONS REGARDING:
 - EXTREME RISK PROTECTIVE ORDERS
 - DOMESTIC VIOLENCE PROTECTIVE ORDERS
 - PEACE ORDERS
