Introduction

On March 7, 2022, under Chief Judge Getty's March 1, 2022 <u>Fifth Amended Administrative</u> <u>Order Expanding Statewide Judiciary Operations in Light of the COVID-19 Emergency</u> and in response to the state's improved health metrics regarding COVID-19 cases continuing to decline, the Maryland Judiciary returned to Phase V of its progressive reopening plan. Shortly thereafter, on March 28th, Chief Judge Getty issued an <u>administrative order</u> lifting the COVID health emergency as it pertains to the Maryland Judiciary. Preceding the March 2022 orders, due to the surge in Maryland of COVID-19 cases as a result of the Omicron variant, the Judiciary re-entered Phase III on December 29, 2021 under Chief Judge Getty's December 27, 2021 <u>Interim Administrative Order Restricting Statewide Judiciary Operations in Light of the Omicron Variant of the COVID-19 Emergency</u>.

On April 26, 2021 the Maryland Judiciary transitioned from Phase IV to Phase V of the Judiciary's Coronavirus phased reopening plan, and courts resumed full operations. Before the resumption of full operations on April 26, 2021, the Judiciary had transitioned from Phase II (second wave) to Phase IV on March 15, 2021. Phase II operational guidelines were resumed on November 30, 2020 in response to a second wave (Delta variant) of COVID-19 cases in Maryland, and consistent with guidance from the Center for Disease Control (CDC). Before the second wave of Phase II, the Judiciary had successfully moved from Phase I through IV of the Judiciary's Phased Reopening Plan and briefly re-entered Phase III from November 16, 2020 to November 30, 2020.

Report 6. July 2021-September 2021 (Phase V operations)

This report (Report 7) provides an update on activities during subsequent COVID operational phases. The purpose of this document is to provide a statistical record of select judicial operations during the months of October 2021 through December 2021, during which the Judiciary operated under the Phase V (fully operational) environment, but still subject to social distancing and health screening for courthouse entry. Data from the same time period in 2020 (Phase, II, III, and IV) is provided for statistical comparison. All previous COVID-19 Statistical Documents can be found on the Judiciary's website1. 


Figure 1: Monthly Circuit Court Domestic Violence Original Case Filings for Protective Orders, 2020 and 2021




Figure 2: Monthly Circuit Court Protective Orders Issued, 2020 and 2021




Figure 3: Monthly Circuit Court Domestic Violence Hearings Held/Concluded, 2020 and 2021




Figure 4: Monthly Circuit Court Original Case Filings — Case Category: Civil, 2020 and 2021




Figure 5: Monthly Circuit Court Original Case Filings — Case Type: Foreclosure (Non-Commercial), 2020 and 2021




Figure 6: Monthly Circuit Court Civil Hearings Held/Concluded, 2020 and 2021




Figure 7: Monthly Circuit Court Original Case Filings — Case Category: Civil-Family, 2020 and 2021




Figure 8: Monthly Circuit Court Original Case Filings — Case Type: Child Custody (Versus), 2020 and 2021




Figure 9: Monthly Circuit Court Original Case Filings — Case Type: Child Support (Agency), 2020 and 2021




Figure 10: Monthly Circuit Court Original Case Filings — Case Type: Divorce (Absolute), 2020 and 2021




Figure 11: Monthly Circuit Court Original Case Filings — Case Type: Divorce (Limited), 2020 and 2021




Figure 12: Monthly Circuit Court Civil-Family Hearings Held/Concluded, 2020 and 2021




Figure 13: Monthly Circuit Court Divorce Hearings Held/Concluded — Contested, 2020 and 2021




Figure 14: Monthly Circuit Court Divorce Hearings Held/Concluded — Uncontested, 2020 and 2021




Figure 15: Monthly Circuit Court Original Case Filings — Case Category: Juvenile, 2020 and 2021




Figure 16: Monthly Circuit Court Juvenile Hearings Held/Concluded, 2020 and 2021




Figure 17: Monthly Circuit Court Child in Need of Assistance (CINA) Hearings Held/Concluded 2020 and 2021




Figure 18: Monthly Circuit Court Original Case Filings — Case Category: Criminal, 2020 and 2021




Figure 19: Monthly Circuit Court — Criminal Pleas (Total Charges Pled), 2020 and 2021




Figure 20: Monthly Circuit Court — Criminal Pleas (Unique Cases), 2020 and 2021




Figure 21: Monthly Circuit Court Criminal Hearings Held/Concluded, 2020 and 2021




Figure 22: Monthly Circuit Court Bail Review Hearings Held/Concluded, 2020 and 2021

Circuit court bail review hearings held/concluded increased 2.9% in October 2021 (676 circuit court bail review hearings held/concluded) compared to October 2020 (657 circuit court bail review hearings held/concluded). In November 2021, there were 703 circuit court bail review hearings held/concluded, an increase of 16.2% from November 2020 and an increase of 4.0% from October 2021. In December 2021, there were 748 circuit court bail review hearings held/concluded, a decrease of 11.6% from December 2020 and an increase of 6.4% from November 2021.




Figure 23: Monthly Circuit Court — Criminal Dispositions (Charges), 2020 and 2021

There were 47,088 circuit court criminal dispositions (charges) from October 2021 to December 2021. Circuit court criminal dispositions (charges) increased 61.5% in October 2021 (17,459 circuit court criminal dispositions (charges)) compared to October 2020 (10,810 circuit court criminal dispositions (charges)). In November 2021, there were 15,386 circuit court criminal dispositions (charges), an increase of 80.4% from November 2020 and a decrease of 11.9% from October 2021. In December 2021, there were 14,243 circuit court criminal dispositions (charges), an increase of 124.9% from December 2020 and a decrease of 7.4% from November 2021.




Figure 24: Monthly Circuit Court — Criminal Dispositions (Cases), 2020 and 2021

There were 9,702 circuit court criminal dispositions (cases) from October 2021 to December 2021. Circuit court criminal dispositions (cases) increased 47.7% in October 2021 (3,521 circuit court criminal dispositions (cases)) compared to October 2020 (2,384 circuit court criminal dispositions (cases)). In November 2021, there were 3,178 circuit court criminal dispositions (cases), an increase of 71.7% from November 2020 and a decrease of 9.7% from October 2021. In December 2021, there were 3,003 circuit court criminal dispositions (cases), an increase of 138.5% from December 2020 and a decrease of 5.5% from November 2021.




Figure 25: Monthly District Court Domestic Violence Original Case Filings for Protective Orders 2020 and 2021




Figure 26: Monthly Total District Court Domestic Violence Protective Orders, 2020 and 2021




Figure 27: Monthly District Court Domestic Violence Protective Order Hearings Held/Concluded, 2020 and 2021




Figure 28: Monthly District Court ERPO Original Case Filings, 2020 and 2021




Figure 29: Monthly Total District Court ERPOs, 2020 and 2021




Figure 30: Monthly District Court ERPO Hearings Held/Concluded, 2020 and 2021




Figure 31: Monthly District Court Peace Order Original Case Filings, 2020 and 2021




Figure 32: Monthly Total District Court Peace Orders, 2020 and 2021




Figure 33: Monthly District Court Peace Order Hearings Held/Concluded, 2020 and 2021




Figure 34: District Court Civil Case Filings, 2020 and 2021




Figure 35: District Court Civil Hearings Held/Concluded 2020 and 2021




Figure 36: District Court Emergency Evaluations Filed, 2020 and 2021




Figure 37: District Court Emergency Evaluations Granted, 2020 and 2021




Figure 38: District Court Criminal Cases Filed 2020 and 2021




Figure 39: District Court Criminal Pleas, 2020 and 2021




Figure 40: District Court Criminal Hearings Held/Concluded 2020 and 2021




Figure 41: District Court Criminal Bail Review Hearings 2020 and 2021




Figure 42: District Court Criminal Dispositions 2020 and 2021




Figure 43: District Court Criminal Trial Dispositions, 2020 and 2021




Figure 44: District Court Criminal Non-Trial Dispositions 2020 and 2021




Figure 45: District Court Motor Vehicle Cases Filed, 2020 and 2021




Figure 46: District Court Motor Vehicle Case Pleas, 2020 and 2021




Figure 47: District Court Motor Vehicle Hearings Held/Concluded, 2020 and 2021




Figure 48: District Court Motor Vehicle Bail Review Hearings, 2020 and 2021




Figure 49: District Court Motor Vehicle Dispositions, 2020 and 2021





Figure 50: Problem-Solving Court (PSC) Hearings, Number of Participants in Attendance 2020, and 2021




Figure 52: District Court Case Monthly Original Filings by Category – March 2019-December 2021
