

ADR SERVICES IN THE DISTRICT COURT OF MARYLAND

The District Court of Maryland's Alternative Dispute Resolution (ADR) Office provides **MEDIATION** and **SETTLEMENT CONFERENCES** in pending **civil** cases in many District Court locations. These **ADR** services are offered at no charge, either on the *day of trial* or *before the trial date* (through District Court ADR Programs) and are distinguished as follows:



MEDIATION – an impartial mediator supports participants in a conversation to help them try to reach a mutually agreeable resolution of their own creation. The mediator does not evaluate any aspect of the case or suggest solutions.

SETTLEMENT CONFERENCE – an experienced attorney serves as the neutral and may evaluate the strengths and weaknesses of a case and may make suggestions to assist the participants with settling the case.

Program availability varies from county to county. Information about available services by county provided for on the opposite side of this sheet. PreTrial ADR

- ★ **Mediation** – Civil cases are referred to one of our partner community mediation centers or law school mediation clinics for **mediation** before the trial date. An impartial mediator will meet with the participants and their attorneys (if applicable) at a time and location that is convenient to *all* participants. If the case is not resolved at the pretrial mediation, the case goes to trial on the scheduled trial date.
- ★ **Settlement Conference** – Settlement conference attorneys meet with the participants and their attorneys (if applicable) at the courthouse *before* the trial date. If the case is not resolved in the settlement conference, the case goes to trial on the scheduled trial date.

Day of Trial ADR

- ★ **Mediation** – An impartial mediator meets with the participants at the courthouse on the day of trial. If the case is not resolved in mediation, the case goes forward to trial. *If a party would like their case to go to mediation, s/he may ask the courtroom clerk, the bailiff, or the judge if a mediator is available.*
- ★ **Settlement Conference** – A settlement conference attorney meets with participants at the courthouse on the day of trial. If the case is not resolved in the settlement conference, the case goes forward to trial.

Peace Orders

- ★ **Peace Order Mediation** - Select cases may be referred to a local community mediation center or neutral mediator prior to or at the time of a peace order hearing. Cases involving recent or ongoing physical abuse, domestic violence, or weapons are not referred to mediation. Cases referred to mediation are carefully screened and individual interviews are conducted to determine appropriateness for mediation prior to services being provided.
