Cecil County

Beginning Monday, June 8^{th,} a majority of the staff will return to the Clerk's Office. We will have 10 of the 15 clerks in the office, and only those who sit diagonal from each other in the desk quads. We will have one cashier and each courtroom will be staffed with one courtroom clerk.

During the first week, both courtrooms will begin operating and will be handling DV/PO cases.

On Thursday, June 11th, we will begin hearing Breach of Lease and Wrongful Detainer cases.

The following week, June 15th, Judge Schneider will be holding criminal trials for incarcerated defendants in Courtroom 1, two cases in the morning session and two cases in the afternoon session. In Courtroom 2, Judge Campbell will continue to hear the interim DV/PO cases from the Commissioner, final DV/PO hearings as they are scheduled, remotely when feasible, conduct Preliminary Inquiry sessions and bail reviews as needed. The dockets will hopefully increase in the number of cases scheduled as the State's Attorney and Public Defender's Office forward pleas to be scheduled.

We will continue to set cases from the beginning of the closure in March to work through the backlog.
