Spans multiple areas of law


Section 8 / Public Housing is a public benefit, but is generally viewed through the LLT lens

Common Areas of Concern


- Eligibility requirements
- Applying for benefits
- Appealing a benefit determination
- Language and technology access

Details to Know

- Addressed mainly by state and federal law; most programs founded at the federal level are managed at the state level
- Rarely a court-related matter; more often, an administrative hearing matter
- Referrals often include government agencies
- Complex subject means extensive general resource reading
