WHEREAS, this Court's Standing Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure submitted its One Hundred Ninety-First Report to the Court, recommending, *inter alia*, the proposed deletion of current Title 18, Chapter 400 (Judicial Discipline) and adoption of a new Title 18, Chapter 400 (Judicial Disabilities and Discipline); and

WHEREAS, this Court, by Rules Order dated December 13, 2016, deferred action on the proposed revision of Title 18, Chapter 400; and

WHEREAS, this Court now wishes to recommit the proposed revision to its Rules Committee for further study in light of developments in the law; now, therefore, it is this 8<sup>th</sup> day of May, 2018

ORDERED, by the Court of Appeals of Maryland, that the proposed revision of Title 18, Chapter 400 be, and it is hereby, remanded to the Standing Committee on Rules of Practice and Procedure for further study by the Committee; and it is further
