As part of its mission to provide fair, efficient, and effective justice for all, the Maryland Judiciary receives state funds each year to support the Judicare program. This funding opportunity is non-competitive and is by invitation only.

Grant Purpose

This grant is being offered to enhance the courts' ability to provide meaningful access to justice. A single grant will be awarded to fund the Judicare program with the aim of expanding access to full representation for low-income persons in family law cases. Priority will be given to individuals with contested custody cases, but funds can be used for other family law matters where full representation is warranted. The grantee shall subaward funds to eligible civil legal service providers to operate the program,

Availability and Awards of Funds

The availability of funds is contingent upon the provision of funds in the Maryland Judiciary budget by the Maryland General Assembly for Fiscal Year 2026. Applicants who are awarded funding will receive notice in early June of 2025.

Funding Cycle: July 1, 2025 - June 30, 2026

Match Requirements

The grantee must match up to a minimum of \$350,000 per year.
