On June 18, 2024, Terrence Edward Hammock, appellant, filed in the Circuit Court for Baltimore County a notice of appeal from the court’s denial of a “Motion for a Judgment Notwithstanding the Verdict and/or Judgment of Acquittal” (hereinafter “motion for judgment”). But, in his brief, Mr. Hammock challenges not the court’s denial of the motion for judgment, but its denial, on July 8, 2024, of a motion to correct illegal sentence. Because Mr. Hammock did not file a notice of appeal from the court’s denial of the motion to correct illegal sentence, and his brief does not address the judgment from which he filed the appeal, we shall dismiss the appeal.
